



- June TBD: Photo Days







DROP-OFF / PICK-UP

- Arrive 5 minutes prior to class
- Parking/stopping is prohibited on west side of Huron St. including drop-off/pick-up
- Find a parking spot as per the map
- Get Moore Auto requires full use of their parking lot during their business hours. This lot is available to DanceRoom families after 5:30pm
- Do not block garage doors, entrances, other vehicles, etc.
- If waiting in your vehicle, use the Tourism lot several buildings north
- Dancers 8 and under should be escorted to and from the building by a parent
- Parents may sit in the waiting room during class and enjoy the live feed
- There is an eating/homework area for dancers with breaks between classes







FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS & PAYMENTS

REGISTRATION

Registration without payment is not accepted. Spots may be forfeited without payment.

CANCELLATION

<u>There are no refunds on payments received.</u> If withdrawing from our fall/winter program, The DanceRoom Inc. must be notified via email within 30 days of program start date. Cheques will be returned/your credit card will be withdrawn from auto-pay. Costume fees, photos fees, and competitive entry fees are non-refundable.

INSTALMENTS

Instalments must be paid on the 1st of the month via cheque or credit card. Parents must be enrolled in autopay if paying instalments by credit card. Cash is not accepted unless payment is in full.

OVERDUE/DECLINED PAYMENTS

Late payments, NSF cheques and declined credit card charges are subject to a \$25 fee to be paid via e-transfer only to info@thedanceroom.ca (password *purple*). Dancers may be suspended upon payment failure. Accounts owing will be unable to participate in recital, collect costuming, register for future programming.



POLICIES

CLASS CANCELLATIONS

- In case of special weather statement or poor road conditions, check the status of classes before venturing out
- Class cancellations are announced at least one hour prior to the first class of the evening via email, text and social media.

CONDUCT:

We ask that all students and family members...

- Seek assistance from staff members when conflicts must be resolved
- Use appropriate language towards all others on studio premises
- Conduct themselves in a positive, supportive, and respectful manner; negative comments or poor behaviour may result in the loss of studio privileges

ABSENTEEISM/LATENESS:

- Mark absences through your parent portal (attendance > Report Absence)
- Numerous missed classes may result in the inability to participate in programming
- Dancers arriving late are encouraged to safely warm up prior to entry, and participate the remainder of class

OTHER:

- Programs will be provided virtually in lieu of in-studio classes in the case of health/safety recommendations.
- Teaching dance is a hands-on practice. Hands-on teaching methods help students understand proper alignment. If your dancer is uncomfortable with hands-on methods, notify us.
- Seek permission from staff to perform studio choreographies elsewhere
- Inform us if your dancer is participating at another studio during programming at The DanceRoom

- Loose jewelry must be removed and long hair pulled back

- 30 days after the program start date, dancers must adhere to the uniform
- If dancers have classes back to back which include ballet, ballet uniforms take precedence

CLASS TYPES

TECH

- Focus exclusively on skills and exercises
- Tech classes do not perform in recital, and have no additional recital fees (costumes, recital tickets, photos, etc.)
- May be invited to be assessed by a qualified examiner
- Examinations are recognized worldwide and enhance the prospect for a career in the dance field

REC

- Focus on skills and choreography
- During Term 2, dancers work on a routine performed in our May recital at the Orillia Opera House
- Dancers receive an age-appropriate costume, professional dance portraits, and a FREE digital copy of the year-end recital
- Dancers interested in participating in recital must be registered for Term 2, and are encouraged to attend Term 1 to build skill

COMP

- By invitation & audition only
- Year-round commitment, taking dancers' training to the next level
- Perform in 2 shows, 3 spring-time competitions, & community events
- Part- & full-time teams to serve varying commitment levels/availability





RECITAL

FOR TERM 2 REC AND COMP DANCERS ONLY

REHEARSAL

- Morning of Saturday May 11th At Orillia Opera House
- Mandatory for performers
- Dancers 11 and under must be accompanied by only one adult in the theatre
- Dancers 12+ must be dropped off with no accompanying adult
- Comp routines will not be rehearsed
- Rehearsal is in order of age, NOT recital order
- Dancers can remain in the theatre for the entire rehearsal as this is their opportunity to watch the show
- Dancers must be picked up following rehearsal; the theatre shuts down and is unsupervised between rehearsal and recital

RECITAL

- Afternoon of Saturday May 11th at Orillia Opera House
- Tickets go on sale through the Oper House (web or phone) in early spring
- One show only
- Dancers arrive in first costume with hair and make-up done, in correct tights/shoes (more info to come)
- Dancers 11 and under are signed in upon entry and parents receive a security card for pick-up
- For safety/security of dancers, there are no visitors in the change-room during the show/intermission
- During recital, dancers wait in change-rooms and rehearsal area with supervision and activities
- If an issue arises, parents will be contacted in the theatre
- All mini routines are scheduled for act 1; if you feel your mini dancer needs to leave at intermission, you may pick them up at that time
